Roll Call: Councilman Delengowski, Councilwoman Hook Councilwoman Jones, Councilwoman Lewis, and Councilman Passon were present. Councilman Beeman was absent (excused).

Motion made by Councilman Passon to approve the minutes from the regular meeting held on September 7, 2009 and the working session/coordinating meeting held on September 21, 2009. Seconded by Councilwoman Lewis. All ayes.

Motion made by Councilman Passon to approve the vouchers provided the proper affidavits are attached. Seconded by Councilwoman Hook. Roll call vote: Councilman Delengowski-yes, Councilwoman Hook-yes, Councilwoman Jones-yes, Councilwoman Lewis-yes, Councilman Passon-yes.

REPORTS:

Councilwoman Lewis-reported that the MPB earned \$1,580.00 in August 2009 and \$900.00 in September 2009 bringing the year-to-date total to \$13,160.00

Councilwoman Jones-reported on that Voorhees Senior Living is having an Octoberfest on Wednesday, October 7, 2009 and Collingswood Grand Ballroom is having a Senior Harvest Dance on Wednesday, October 21, 2009.

Councilman Delengowski-reported that the transfer switch on the generator at the fire house has been installed.

Councilwoman Hook-reported that she would discuss fundraising committees under New Business.

Councilman Passon-reported that the state approved Audubon Park's emergency application to exclude from the CAP the Solar Energy Feasibility Study.

Mayor Pennock-reported that he attended Haddon Township Day, Audubon Park Fire Department's Fire Prevention Day, and Emergency Management meeting with the State Police, George Martin, and Rudy Young. The Coordinating meeting went well, Frank Seney of Remington and Vernick will be presenting bids for the asbestos at the

neighborhood facility, and the fire department will be having a Halloween Parade.

Motion made by Councilman Passon to approve the letter to the residents requiring information on school aged children. Seconded by Councilwoman Lewis. All ayes. (Solicitor Platt recommended that a line be added that states privacy will be respected this information will not be given out to other organizations.)

Motion made by Councilman Passon to do a letter of support for the senior lunch program. Seconded by Councilman Delengowski. All ayes.

Motion made by Councilwoman Jones to adopt the Shared Services Agreement with the County of Camden for Snow Removal. Seconded by Councilman Delengowski. All ayes.

Motion made by Councilman Delengowski to allow Mayor Larry Pennock, the Director of Public Safety to set the curfew for Mischief Night and Halloween. Seconded by Councilwoman Lewis.

Motion made by Councilman Passon to have trick-or-treating from 1 PM until 5 PM on October 31, 2009. Seconded by Councilwoman Jones. All ayes.

Motion made by Councilman Delengowski to adopt the Amendment to the Shared Services Agreement between the Borough of Audubon Park and Haddon Township for the Provision of Police Protection and Municipal Court Services. Seconded by Councilman Passon. Roll call vote: Councilman Delengowski-yes, Councilwoman Hook-yes, Councilwoman Jones-yes, Councilman Lewis-yes, and Councilman Passon-yes.

Discussion was held regarding town organizations being covered under the Borough umbrella.
