WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Audubon Park to reallocate \$3,441.79 from Year 30 funding and \$19,655.00 from YR 31 funding from the Neighborhood facility to the Audubon Park Tot Lot and Basketball Court Recreational areas on Roads "A" and "B" , and
