**RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH OF AUDUBON PARK,
COUNTY OF CAMDEN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AUTHORIZING
THE FUNDING FOR MUNICIPAL ALLIANCES
NO. 2011:50**

WHEREAS, the Borough of Audubon Park, County of Camden, State of New Jersey recognizes that the abuse of alcohol and drugs is a serious problem in our society amongst persons of all ages; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Audubon Park further recognizes that it is incumbent upon not only public officials but upon the entire community to take action to prevent such abuses in our community; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Audubon Park has applied for funding to the Governor's Council on Alcoholism and Drug Abuse through the County of Camden;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Audubon Park, County of Camden, State of New Jersey that they hereby recognize the following:

3. The Borough of Audubon Park does hereby authorize submission of an application for the Audubon Park Municipal Alliance Grant for calendar year 2012 in the amount of \$27,076.00.
4. The Borough of Audubon Park acknowledges the terms and conditions for administering the Municipal Alliance Grant, including the administrative compliance and audit requirements.
