

**MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE MAYOR AND BOROUGH COUNCIL
OF THE BOROUGH OF AUDUBON PARK, IN THE COUNTY OF CAMDEN, NEW
JERSEY, HELD APRIL 21, 2014 IN THE ANNEX BUILDING AT 7:00 PM.**

A regular meeting of the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Audubon Park was convened in the Annex Building, 504 Road A, Audubon Park, NJ on Monday, April 21, 2014, at 7:00 PM.

Mayor Pennock requested all stand for the flag salute.

Mayor Pennock announced that Chapter 231, Public Law 1975 requires adequate notice of this meeting be provided. This was done by placing Annual Notice in the Courier-Post and Retrospect Newspapers and by posting on the bulletin board in the Municipal Building.

REPORTS:

Councilwoman Jones reported on the following Free Senior Events sponsored by Camden County:

Councilman Carpinelli reported that the 4th of July Committee would like to request a donation from the Mayor and Borough Council for this year's celebration.

Motion made by Councilman Delengowski to pay up to \$2,000 in bills for the 4th of July Committee's 2014 Celebration provided the proper affidavits are attached, seconded by Councilwoman DiPasquale. Roll call vote: Councilman Carpinelli-yes, Councilman Delengowski-yes, Councilwoman DiPasquale-yes, Councilwoman Hook-yes, Councilwoman Jones-yes, and Councilwoman Lewis-yes.

Councilwoman Lewis reported that SCUCS need to clean-up on Fridays after the senior luncheon. She commented that it is taking the janitors 1 hour to do what should have been done in 30 minutes. She requested that the contract between the Borough of Audubon Park and SCUCS be pulled and sent to her for review. Mayor Pennock advised Councilwoman Lewis that the water utility at the MPB is high and there is probably a leak in or around the toilet in the men's room.

The Mayor reported on the following:

- Negotiated \$3,500 for bus with Haddon Township and we are waiting to see if that amount has been accepted;
- Conversation with Beth Pugh confirms that CDBG funds can be used for the bus maintenance, upkeep, salary of bus driver, etc;
- Peter Creek Clean-up is scheduled for May 3rd;
- Tentative date for Summer Concert is June 6th and the County has already been contacted about the stage;
- May 5th is the Budget Hearing;
- Sending letter to Audubon Soccer requesting that their equipment be removed from the Audubon Park Soccer Field since they will no longer be using the field; and
- Condition of Baseball Field

Motion made by Councilman Carpinelli to approach Audubon Mutual Housing Board of Trustees about transferring the baseball field to the Borough, seconded by Councilman Delengowski. Roll call vote: Councilman Carpinelli-yes, Councilman Delengowski-yes, Councilwoman DiPasquale-yes, Councilwoman Hook-yes, Councilwoman Jones and Councilwoman Lewis-yes.
