

DRAINAGE ISSUES ON EAGLE ROAD

Even though Audubon Mutual Housing Corporation is responsible for the Drainage issues on Eagle Road, the Mayor and Borough Council still attempted to secure a grant from NJ DOT to alleviate this issue. Unfortunately, the Mayor received a letter from the NJ DOT stating, "Unfortunately, the NJDOT is unable to provide a Municipal Aid grant for the Drainage and Roadway Improvements to Eagle Road Cul-De-Sac and Goldfinch Road Cul-De-Sac. The Municipal Aid Program continues to be a popular and competitive program. This year's solicitation resulted in 653 applications requesting more than \$255 million of the \$78.75 million available. NJ DOT makes every effort to fund as many projects as possible, but the funding needs far exceed available resources."
