## ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF AUDUBON PARK, COUNTY OF CAMDEN AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2015-03, ENTITLED "DOGS, GENERAL REGULATIONS"

WHEREAS, the Borough of Audubon Park ("Borough") is a municipal entity organized and existing under the laws of the State of New Jersey and located in Camden County; and

**WHEREAS,** on April 6, 2015, the Governing Body adopted Ordinance No. 2015-03 which repealed and replaced Ordinance No. 2010-09 establishing licensing requirements and regulating the ownership and control of dogs within the Borough; and

**WHEREAS,** on November 6, 2017, the Governing Body adopted Ordinance No. 2017-06 which amended Section 1.4 of Ordinance No. 2015-03 which established certain licensing fees regarding the registration of dogs; and

**WHEREAS,** Section 3.4 of Ordinance No. 2015-03 established procedures concerning the hearing, declaration, and the requirements of the owner of potentially vicious and/or dangerous dogs; and

**WHEREAS,** Section 3.5 of Ordinance No. 2015-03 established duties of the owner of a potentially dangerous dog; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:48-2, the Governing Body is authorized to enact and amend ordinances as deemed necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and as may be necessary to carry into effect the powers and duties conferred and imposed upon the Borough by law;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Audubon Park, County of Camden, and State of New Jersey, as follows:

**SECTION 1:** Ordinance No. 2015-03, entitled "Dogs, General Regulations, Article III, entitled "Potentially Dangerous and/or Vicious Dogs, Section 3.4, entitled "Hearing; Declaration; Requirements of Owner" is hereby amended, revised and/or supplemented to read as follows:

- (2) that the dog shall be destroyed in a humane and expedition manner.
